Typed applications are preferred so please create a new document.

Please make sure everything is numbered and that all of the questions are included.

1. Describe a situation in which you demonstrated leadership. Why would you categorize it as "leadership"?
2. Choose one activity or organization that you are, or hope to be, involved in. How do you see yourself impacting that activity / organization in the long term?
3. Why did you choose to apply for the Impact Rice Retreat?
4. What is one issue on Rice campus you would like to see addressed and why?
5. What leadership skills would you like to develop on the retreat, and how will you share those skills upon your return to Rice?
6. Imagine yourself at graduation, what do you want to say you accomplished during your time here?
7. Write a haiku about yourself. (A haiku is 3 lines. The first and third lines are 5 syllables, and the second line is 7 syllables. It does not need to rhyme.)
8. Fill in the box with something that appeals to you. (It does not need to be elaborate.)
